**A note about your Emergency Contact List:**

**When an alarm signal is received at the Central Station, their first call is to the premises telephone.**

**If they get a busy signal or no one answers, they call Emergency Responders (Police if it's a burglar alarm, Fire if it's a smoke or heat alarm).**

**Then they call numbers on your contact list, until they reach someone.**

**If you want certain numbers to be called prior to Police dispatch, PLEASE STATE THAT EXPLICITLY IN THE COMMENTS SECTION ON THE PREVIOUS PAGE.**

**It is important to stay off the phone if you have set off your alarm by mistake – if the Central Station cannot reach the premises, they will call the Police.**

**The exception to this rule is if you have sent in a Silent Panic signal from your keypad or remote – on receipt of this signal, the Central Station immediately dispatches Police. If you send a Silent Panic signal by mistake, call the Central Station right away.**

**Many jurisdictions levy fines for excessive dispatches for false alarms.**
